

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes the ways in which Personal Information about individuals (“**Users**”) who use this application (the “**Website**”) may be collected, stored and used by IPSEN PHARMA SAS (“**Ipsen**”), the data controller.

THIS PRIVACY POLICY MAY PERIODICALLY CHANGE, BE MODIFIED, OR OTHERWISE UPDATED WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION. However, your Personal Information (as defined below) will always be handled in accordance with the Privacy Policy that was in effect at the time of collection.

1. Personal Information collected:

Ipsen may collect Personal Information when you register to become a User, including your name, e-mail address, country of residence, password, affiliation and job title (“Personal Information”). If you wish to submit an Investigator Sponsored Study, these categories of Personal Information are mandatory.

When you register as a User, we clearly label which information is required for registration, and which information is optional and may be given at your discretion.

2. Use of Personal Information:

By providing Personal Information you request Ipsen to:

- Administer your account and store your personal preferences.
- Send you service communications through email (i.e. password changes).
- Track the ISS
- Review your publication

Your Personal Information will only be processed for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by Ipsen, namely, tracking of the ISS, publication creation.

Your Personal Information will not be sold, shared or otherwise distributed to third parties without your consent, except where we are required to do so because of an applicable law, court order or governmental regulation, or if such disclosure is otherwise necessary in support of any criminal or other legal investigation or proceeding here or abroad.

3. Term of retention of Personal Information

Your Personal Information is processed and kept for no more than three years from the latter: (i) its collection or (ii) the latest contact we have with you.

4. Security

Your Personal Information will be stored on secure servers and maintained strictly confidential. You are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your unique password and account information.

5. Right of access, correction and objection

You have a right of access, correction, deletion, restriction and objection to the use of your Personal Information. If you wish to contact us regarding our use of your Personal Information or exercise any of your rights regarding your Personal Information, please email us at consent@ipsen.com. If you contact us, please indicate the specific reason why you are contacting us and include a copy of a piece of identification (e.g., ID card, passport, driver’s license), subject to applicable legal requirements. Requests to delete personal data will be subject to any applicable legal and ethical reporting or document filing or retention obligations imposed on us. In this case, you will be informed about this and your Personal Information will only be retained to meet those purposes.
